Chaplain's Corner

Sic Semper Tyrannis

"Sic Semper Tyrannis" is the state motto of Virginia. It is a Latin phrase that means "Thus always to tyrants." What is the Thus? It could be death always to tyrants. Victory always over tyrants. May justice always fall upon tyrants. May tyrants always meet a dire end, which is just and which we should expect.

In the context of our Independence in 1776 and the Revolutionary War, it clearly was meant to symbolize the fight of Virginia (and the rest of the Colonies) against the tyranny of the English Parliament and the English King, George III. George Mason recommended it to be in the Seal of Virginia during the 1776 Virginia Convention. It is a clear reminder that our way of life is built on freedom and virtue, not on tyranny.

The motto is still relevant to us today. First, it reminds us of the cry of the human heart for justice. Second, it shows us what must be done to sustain freedom and virtue. Finally, brings people together who desire freedom and virtue over tyranny.

First, it is natural for people to wish and desire that tyranny would come to a glorious end. We desire justice and part of justice in this world is to see the end of tyranny. Whether that tyranny be at the hands a single person, or a system of government, or an attitude of society, the Administrative state, or our local elected officials. Only the most ardent, and twisted loyalists to a tyrant or tyranny mourn the death or end, while it gives lovers of freedom and virtue something to celebrate.

Second, it is still relevant for us today because it reminds us what must be done to keep freedom and virtue – we must put end to tyrants and tyranny. It reminds us we are in the battle everyday, every year, for one tyrant is always replaced by another.

Finally, Sic Semper Tyrannis is relevant today because freedom is not sustained by the overthrow of tyrants and tyranny, as important as that may be. There will always be someone or something to take their place. It gives us an opportunity to continue to promote freedom and sustain those things that promote and keep freedom. And Freedom is sustained because there are people who have come together work to promote and sustain freedom.

Of course, the Legion is one such organization and gathering of people who work to end tryants and tyranny by promoting freedom and virtue. We are upholding and defending the Constitution of the United States. We help maintain law and order. We foster and perpetuate a one hundred percent Americanism. We combat the autocracy (think tyranny) of both the classes and the masses. We safeguard and transmit to posterity the principles of Justice, freedom and democracy.

So friends, let us work together to give to tyrants of any kind what they deserve by working together and showing others the ideals and practical implications of freedom and virtue. VA to Stop Issuing Paper Checks

Dear Caregivers and Veterans,

Take action now: Complete your direct deposit/electronic funds transfer (EFT) enrollment.

VA will no longer issue paper checks as of October 1, 2023. To ensure uninterrupted and timely PCAFC stipend payments, all Primary Family Caregivers receiving paper checks must complete the EFT enrollment process as soon as possible or before the deadline

Caregivers can enroll in direct deposit as a vendor through VA's <u>Customer Engagement Portal</u>. To complete the required form, caregivers will need their social security number, address, and bank routing and account numbers. Step-by-step instructions for enrolling can be found in the <u>CSP Direct Deposit Enrollment User Guide</u>.

For Caregivers that don't already have a bank account, the <u>Veterans Benefits Banking Program</u> (VBBP) can connect them with a bank for help setting up an account. Ensuring Timely Payments and Enhancing Security.

A new law, 31 CFR Part 208 – Management of Federal Agency Disbursements, requires that all Federal payments be made through the electronic funds transfer (EFT) system, more commonly known as direct deposit.

CSP recognizes the significance of timely stipend payments for caregivers. The EFT system supports timely stipend payments and enhances security by minimizing fraud risks associated with traditional paper checks.

We understand that adapting to new processes may raise questions or concerns. Should you require any assistance or have inquiries about the EFT enrollment, please contact the VA Financial Services Center's Customer Care Center at 1-877-353-9791. Alternatively, you can reach out to your local CSP team for assistance. Local contact numbers are available on the <u>find your caregiver support team webpage</u>.
